May 11, 2023: CMA Safety Policies for the Music Fest

Hello, BlueShoe/CMA Fest 2023 travelers:

The CMA has safety policies in place that include what you can and cannot bring into the different venues, designated shelter areas in the case of severe weather, first aid stations, rules regarding re-entry / ins and outs of the various music venues, information booths, storage locations, lost and found, and more. Please go to the CMA's FAQ page <https://cmafest.com/faqs/> and familiarize yourself with the following topics:

- Prohibited Items & Activities (tells you what you may and may not bring into the venues)
- Bag Policies—All Locations ALLOWED BAGS: Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 12" x 6" are allowed. All styles of clear bags are acceptable as long as they are 12" x 12" x 6" or smaller – this includes clear backpacks, clear diaper bags, fanny packs, gallon Ziploc bags, etc. In addition to a clear bag, a small clutch bag or wallet 4.5" x 6.5" or smaller is allowed. One approved size clear bag and one approved size small clutch is allowed per person; PROHIBITED BAGS: Prohibited bags include, but are not limited to: non-clear bags of any kind (including mesh, tinted plastic, and clear bags with a printed pattern), clear bags larger than 12" x 12" x 6", coolers, and seat cushions.
- First aid and medical assistance: stations are located in various areas of the Festival. See locations on your [CMA Connect app](#).
- Weather shelters: download [the CMA Connect app](#) and turn on notifications for the latest information. In the case of severe weather, follow the instructions provided on-site immediately.
- See something, say something—report suspicious activity: keep each other safe by reporting suspicious activity immediately. Call 615-880-1515 or, if there's an emergency, call 911 directly.
